Our mathematics offerings begin with Algebra 1 and follow a typical College Prep track through AP Calculus with an optional or concurrent Statistics/AP Statistics track. We are looking for an individual who is excited and able to teach the full range of math courses with a particular focus on AP Calculus. The ability to also teach Statistics and/or Physics will be seen as a significant plus. This full-time teaching position will also advise a group of students, actively participate in the residential life program, and assist with extracurricular activities.

THE IDEAL CANDIDATE WILL BE:

- Passionate about teaching students and sharing their love for mathematics.
- Committed to developing in all Kents Hill students the kinds of sophisticated problem-solving and critical-thinking strategies needed for success beyond secondary education.
- Excited to actively collaborate in the 4D curriculum through course design, pedagogy, and assessment.
- Culturally competent with skills for engaging with and learning from people with diverse backgrounds and experiences.
- Committed to the entire student experience and want to engage with students both inside and outside of the classroom. Typically, this includes:
 - Living in a campus residence and participating in all aspects of residential life.
 - Advising a group of students.
 - Involvement in afternoon and extracurricular activities.
