THE LEARNING SPECIALIST WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR:

- Working with children grades 6-12.
- Collaborating with teachers and Learning Lab Director in order to meet the range of needs of the students, which could include working with small groups of students to teach organization and planning skills (Executive Functioning), study skills, assist with classroom work when needed, reading and writing skills. Math skills are welcomed.
- Working with Google classroom and helping students monitor daily planner and "chunk" classroom assignments.
- Confirming that students are receiving the accommodations they need within the school's capacity and helping to present information to teachers regarding differentiation in their classrooms.
- Helping to identify students through informal and formal assessment, who may need more support.
- Collaborating regularly with teachers, parents, and director, including scheduled parent conferences.
- Documenting daily lessons and student progress; keeping careful anecdotal and assessment records to contribute to the writing of accurate, comprehensive reports.
- Participating in ongoing professional development to keep abreast of developments in the field.
- Providing professional development to teachers around topics related to learning diversity.
